In the matter of Canvassing the vote cast at General Election of November 2nd 1880.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the matter of the canvassing of the vote cast at the General Election held November 2nd 1880. J. W. Green asked permission to file a written request to the Board asking that the ballots be by said Board Canvassed ^{and} Counted, so far as the same pertain to the office of County Attorney. Geo. I. Barker appeared as Attorney for Mr. Green ^{and} J. C. Walton appeared as attorney for Mr. Albert Knittle who objected to the filing of such paper. The request of Mr. Green to file papers as aforesaid was granted and the Attorney for the opposition accepted the decision of the Board.

The case presented by Mr. Green was argued at length and finally taken under consideration by the Board. The Board then proceeded to canvass the vote for State Officers.
