Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the Office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Heskines, Chairman,
John Hailton & J. C. Hailton & County Clerk W. Stevens.

In the matter of the proposition of
W^m J. Sinclair for Refunding of Certain
Legal Taxes, marked Exhibits "A" "B" & "C".

To The Hon. Board of
County Commissioners.

Gentlemen: I have the honor to state to your Hon.
Board that I will exchange the accompanying claims against the County
marked "A" "B" & "C" amounting to date @ 10% to the sum of \$652⁶⁴/₁₀₀
for County Certificates @ 10% interest, without fees. And if your Hon. Board
accept my proposition I ask you to make an order for the refunding of
said amount & an order authorizing the County Clerk to transfer to me
such County Certificates as I may select @ 10% without fees not exceeding
said sum of \$652⁶⁴/₁₀₀.

the aforesaid matter it was ordered that Special Scrip be issued
in payment of the claims at 10% interest amounting to \$652⁶⁴/₁₀₀ And
that said scrip be payable only in County Certificates at 10% interest
without fees.
