

In the matter of the Petition of  
J. M. Hartman <sup>and others</sup> for the  
Vacation <sup>and</sup> Location of a road.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1881, a Road Petition was filed signed by J. M. Hartman <sup>and</sup> 13 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation <sup>and</sup> Location of a road described as follows: To vacate that part of a County road commencing at N. E. Cor. of S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  running E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to N. E. Cor. of Sec. 12 dividing the N. E. <sup>and</sup> S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 12, T. 15, R. 17.  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile in length, To locate Commencing at Center of Sec. 12, T. 15, R. 17. running thence N. on  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec line as near as practicable through said Sec. 12, <sup>and</sup> Sec. 1, to middle of N. line of said Sec. 1, T. 15, R. 17.  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles. Said Petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by J. M. Hartman, H. S. Jenkins <sup>and</sup> Moses Beaman in the sum of One Thousand Dollars which bond was approved <sup>and</sup> it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Silas Gavin, S. W. Metsker <sup>and</sup> Joseph Michael be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view <sup>and</sup> lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of  
Jacob Geiger <sup>and others</sup> for the  
Vacation of a road.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Jan'y. 1881, a road Petition was filed signed by Jacob Geiger <sup>and</sup> 43 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation of a road described as follows: Commencing in Center of Sec. 22, T. 14, R. 17 running thence N. on  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. line to N. line of said Sec. E. along N. line of said Sec. to N. E. Cor. of said Sec. Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Jacob Geiger as principal and E. K. Flory as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved <sup>and</sup> it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that A. C. Jacobs, W. Scott, <sup>and</sup> John Payn be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
