

In the matter of the Petition of  
 Daniel Kouszegker <sup>and others</sup> for  
 Relocation of a road { On the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of Jan'y. 1881. a road pe-  
 tition was filed signed by Daniel Kouszegker and 11 others and  
 presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the relocation  
 of a road described as follows: Commencing at the 1/4 cor. in E. of Sec. 34  
 T. 12. R. 21. running N. <sup>45</sup> S. E. through said Sec. 34. Relocation prayed for  
 as follows. Beginning at a point about 52. R. N. of beginning of old  
 road in S. boundary of Right of way of A. T. & S. F. R. R. Thence in S. westerly  
 direction along S. boundary of right of way of A. T. & S. F. R. R. to intersection  
 with road on Sec. line between Secs 33. <sup>and</sup> said Sec 34. Said petition  
 was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by  
 Daniel Kouszegker as principal <sup>and</sup> E. D. Phinney as surety in the  
 sum of Fifty Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing  
 to the Board that the law had been substantially complied  
 with it was ordered that C. M. Sears, J. A. Cole <sup>and</sup> Thomas  
 Rayson be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the  
 day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they  
 proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving  
 to all parties a hearing and make due report of their pro-  
 ceedings to this Board.

The Board appointed Commissioner John Walton as a  
 committee to visit and examine the Endra Bridge <sup>and</sup> Commissioner  
 J. C. Walton <sup>and</sup> the County Surveyor as a committee to visit and  
 examine the Lawrence Bridge.

Board adjourned to meet Jan'y 12<sup>th</sup> 1881. at 9 o'clock A. M.
