In the matter of Superintendent of Co. Farm and Poor Asylum. { The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the matter of bids for Superintendent of County Farm and Poor Asylum for the ensuing year the bid of W.H. Ware was accepted. The bid of Mr. Ware was as follows:

Dear Board of County Commissioners: You elected me to the office of Super't of Co. Farm. I have managed and superintended the farm to the best of my ability. If you want to give me the office another year at the same figures I had it last year I'm hundred and forty dollars (\$240.00) I would be glad to have it. If you give it to me another year I will manage the farm as I did last year to the best of my knowledge. I am satisfied that I can improve considerably from last year as I have learned many ways and means to manage the house that I did not know when I first came.
