Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to law at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners D.C. Walton, Chairman, John Walton^{Esq} R.A. Holbe^{Esq} County Clerk M. Stearns

J.B. Hill, Trustee of Decempton Township appeared and made report of the business of said Township for the year ending January 13th 1881. which report was read^{and} approved.

John E. Reming, Trustee of Marion Township, appeared^{and} made report of the business of said Township for the year ending January 13th 1881. which report was read^{and} approved.

E.E. Gaddis, Trustee of Palmyra Township, appeared^{and} made report of the business of said Township for the year ending April 11th 1881. which report was read^{and} approved.

In the matter of the Resolution of the City Council of Lawrence, Submitted to Bd of Co. Commrs. April 11th 1881.

Whereas, there is now outstanding in the name of Douglas County, a large amount of taxes assessed against certain lots in this city for the building of sidewalks in the year 1867, which, with interest and penalties thereon accrued, in many instances amounts to more than the value of the lots against which the assessment was made. Therefore

Resolved, That the owners of such lots be allowed to redeem them from the sale for taxes of 1867, for the amount for which the same was sold so far as the City's interest may appear^{and} that the County Commissioners be requested to remit the interest due on such sale for sidewalk taxes, and that upon the granting of this request by said Board of County Commissioners, the City Clerk be directed to procure a list of the property upon which such taxes are due and publish the same with the conditions upon which such redemption can be made.
