

Lawrence, Kansas, April 13th 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Waller, Chairman, John Waller and O. A. Odell County Clerk. W. O. Stevens.

J. C. Darling, Trustee of Eudora Township appeared and made report of the business of said Township for the year ending January 13th 1881, which report was read and approved.

Etha Baldwin, Trustee of Wakarusa Township appeared and made report of the business of said Township for the year ending January 12th 1881, which report was read and approved.

In the matter of the Petition of }
O. D. Spencer and others for the Location }
of a Road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility, It was ordered that the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and that said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith and record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Dickinson Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the Public use.

The Commissioners record for the January Session 1881, was read and approved with the following protest to the record of the last day of said session:

I solemnly protest against this blank appropriation being made a part of the records from the fact that up to four o'clock on the last day of the Jan session 1881, this appropriation asked for had not been discussed and no action had been taken by the Co Board, Also that I, on Apr 9th 1881, Carefully examined the minutes of the Commissioners Record of the Jan. Session 1881, kept by the County Clerk and found nothing in regard to said appropriation, that the County Clerk when called on, said there was no record of said transaction.
