John Walton^{ing} & P. A. Collier^{ing} County Clerk, M. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of
Gund Krueger^{ing} & others for
the Location of a Road

The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been
offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public
utility. It was ordered that the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey
be adopted and that said road be declared local and established in accordance
therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the
Trustee of Eudora Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for
the public travel.

In the matter of the Cancellation of
illegal sale to County of E¹/₂ of S.W. ¹/₄ of
Sec. 14, T. 15, R. 15. Sale of year 1867.

The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the above matter^{ing} being satisfied that the sale was illegal
It was ordered that the sale to the County, in 1867, of E¹/₂ of S.W. ¹/₄ of Sec. 14, T. 15, R. 15,
be cancelled.

In the matter of the petition of
Jacob Geiger^{ing} & others for the Location
of a road.

After hearing the evidence in the
aforesaid road case the Board took the matter under advisement.
J. M. Hendry appeared as attorney for the petitioners and James M. Green
as attorney for the opposition.

The Board had under consideration the petition of Geo. Behrman
and others for Location^{ing} of a road and the petition of F. M. Hartmann
and others for Location^{ing} of a road and after hearing the evidence in
each case took the matter under advisement.

Board adjourned to meet April 14th 1881, at 9 o'clock, A.M.
