

Lawrence, Kansas, April 16th 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners D. C. Hoston Chairman, John Hoston and P. A. Kelbu County Clerk W. G. Greene.

In the matter of the Petition of
Green B. Swager and others for
the Location of a road.

On the 16th day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Green B. Swager and 17 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows: Begin at the Section corner of 9, 10, 15, 16 of Town 12, Range 19, Thence N. on section line between Sec. 9 and 16, 166 Rods to S.E. cor. of S.H. 1/4 of Sec. 9, T. 12, R. 19. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Green B. Swager as principal and V. R. Bryan as surety in the sum of One Thousand Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Jordan Neal, John M. Faaland and Thad Whedden be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice, together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
H. Bennett for the Change and
Location of a Road.

On the 8th day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by H. Arnold and 49 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the Change and Location of a road described as follows: Change the State Road running through Sec. 15, T. 14, R. 15, 1/4 to locate a road beginning at the N.E. cor of Sec. 15 and running thence to the N.W. cor of said Sec. as near as practicable which, together with a road now on the E of said Sec. will make a perfect connection. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by Law signed by H. Bennett as principal and Albert House as surety in the sum of One Thousand Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the Law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that C. M. Fisher, Henry Weston and Pralter Baker be appointed as Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
