Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners D. C. Walton Chairman, John Walton ^{and} P. A. Kolb ^{and} County Clerk H. G. Stoenne.

In the matter of the Petition of
Gree B. Swager ^{and} others for

the Location of a road.

On the 16th Day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Gree B. Swager ^{and} 17 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows: Begin at the Section corners of T. 10, R. 15, ^{and} 16 of Town 12, Range 19, Section N. in section line between Sec. 9 ^{and} 16, 16th Roads to S.E. cor. of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9, T. 12, R. 19. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Gree B. Swager as principal ^{and} D. R. Bryan as surety in the sum of One Thousand Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Jordan Neal, John McFarland ^{and} Thad Whitten be appointed viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice, together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
W. Bennett for the Change ^{and}

Location of a Road.

On the 8th Day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by C. Arnold ^{and} 49 others ^{and} presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the change ^{and} location of a road described as follows: Change the State Road running through Sec. 18, T. 14, R. 18, ^{and} to locate a road beginning at the N.E. cor. of Sec. 18 and running thence to the N.W. cor. of said Sec. as near as practicable which, together with a road now on the E. of said Sec. will make a perfect connection. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by W. Bennett as principal ^{and} Albert House as surety in the sum of One Thousand Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that C. M. Fisher, Harvey Whitten ^{and} Prather Baker be appointed as viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
