

In the matter of the Petition of
A. B. Heisey ^{and} others for the Change
of a Road.

On the 12th day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by A. B. Heisey ^{and} 12 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the change of a road described as follows: Begin at a point about 100 R. N. of S.E. cor. of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 12, R. 18 running thence Northwesterly about 80 R. to the point of termination about 30 R. N. of Center of said Sec. 22, said road to be altered so as to run from said point of beginning about 60 R. N. to center of said Sec. thence N. on 1/4 Sec. line about 30 R. to said point of termination. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by A. B. Heisey as principal ^{and} H. Hart as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. C. Melsker, Ed. Zimmerman ^{and} W. B. Kennedy be appointed as viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the petition of
J. M. Clunahan ^{and} others for
the vacation ^{and} re-location of a road.

On the 22nd day of March, 1881, a road petition was filed signed by J. M. Clunahan ^{and} 51 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the vacation ^{and} relocation of a road described as follows: Commencing at a point on the present travelled road leading west, at which it strikes the right of way limits of the A. T. & S. F. R.R. to vacate said road to its present terminus near the corner stone at the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 11, R. 17. ^{and} Commencing at said named point of vacation to re-locate said road upon the most practicable ground along the south line of said right of way limits of said R.R. to a point on the west line of Sec. 35, some 30 rods more or less south of the corner stone at the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 35, in Township 11, R. 17. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by ^{as principal}

^{as surety} in the sum of Dollars, which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that M. S. Winters, Wm. Hae ^{and} J. H. Bombrake be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
