

In the matter of the Petition of
Louis Clamm^{es} others for the
Location of a road.

On the 11th day of April 1881, a road petition was
filed, signed by D. W. Seibold^{es} & 14 others and presented to the Board of County
Commissioners, praying for the Location of a road described as follows:
Beginning at the S.W. cor. of Sec. 7, T. 15, R. 21. Thence N. on Sec. line one half mile.
Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by
Louis Clamm as principal^{es} James White as surety, in the sum of Fifty
Dollars, which bond was approved^{es} it appearing to the Board that the law
had been substantially complied with it was ordered that T. D. Sperry,
W. H. Chambers^{es} & David Kostebader be appointed as Viewers of the
said road and that upon the day named in their notice, together with the
County Surveyor, they proceed to view and lay out said road according
to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their
proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
W^m Charles^{es} others for the
re-establishment of a Road.
