

Town of Kauka. April 18<sup>th</sup> 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners D.C. Walton, Chair man, John Walton<sup>and</sup> P.A. Holba<sup>and</sup> County Clerk H.O. Glavin.

In the matter of the Petition of  
Mathias Simon<sup>and</sup> others for  
the Location of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road<sup>as</sup> believing it to be of public utility It was ordered that the Viewers report<sup>as</sup> view<sup>as</sup> report<sup>as</sup> plan of Survey be adopted and that the said road be declared located<sup>as</sup> established in accordance therewith 1/4 mile from N. line running south to 1/4 cor. between Secs. 28<sup>and</sup> 29 T. 14 R. 18 with privilege of gates at South end for 2 years. It was further ordered that full record of this action be made in the County Road record<sup>as</sup> the Trustee of Marion Township be notified to cause the road so established to be opened for the public travel.

In the matter of the Petition of  
J.W. Hartman<sup>and</sup> others for the  
Location of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road<sup>as</sup> no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same<sup>as</sup> believing it to be of public utility It was ordered that the Viewers report and view and report and plan of Survey be adopted<sup>as</sup> that the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record<sup>as</sup> the Trustee of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It was further ordered that the sum of Fifty Dollars be allowed Werner in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location<sup>as</sup> establishment of said road. to be paid at the end of one year provided no non-resident claims are presented. If other claims are presented and allowed the amount is to be deducted from Werner's allowance.

County Bridges<sup>and</sup> The Board having under consideration petitions for appropriations for abutments for County Bridges on Washington Creek near Reynolds' Ford and on Head Creek near Ebenezer Baldwin's farm It was Resolved and ordered by the Board that appropriations for said abutments be made as follows. For abutments at Reynolds' Ford. Six Hundred and Thirty Five Dollars; For abutments near Ebenezer Baldwin's farm Four Hundred Dollars, or such sum as may be necessary for the completion of said abutments.
