

Lawrence, Kansas, April 19<sup>th</sup> 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners D.C. Walton, Chairman, John Walton and P.A. Dolbe<sup>r</sup> County Clerk. H.O. Johnson.

The Board appointed Commissioner Dolbe<sup>r</sup> and the County Surveyor a committee to visit and examine the proposed location for a Bridge at Belvoir.

Reopening or reestablishing of a road. }  
On the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Wm. Choate and others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the review or reestablishing of a road described as follows: From East to West through the center of Sec. 8, T. 15, R. 19, as there is a road from the East line of Town 15 to the 1/2 Sec. line on the East side of Sec. 8. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by William Choate, as principal and John Hoskins as surety in the sum of Fifty Dollars. And it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that A.C. Jacob, J.S. Fletcher and W. Scott be appointed as viewers of the said road and that in the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

Board adjourned to meet April 20<sup>th</sup> 1881, at 9 o'clock A.M.
