Co's interest in lot in N. Lawrence.

The Board of County Commissioners having  
under consideration the aforesaid petition it was ordered that O. W. McAllister be  
admitted to the County interest in lot 29, Simpson's Sub Division, North Lawrence,  
that is for the tax of 1867 with tax of 1868, endorsed, for upon payment to the County  
of Fifteen Dollars. Provided private certificates be purchased or redeemed  
by the petitioner.

In the matter of the Petition of

Isaac Leger & others for the vacation  
of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under  
consideration the aforesaid road & no legal objections having been offered against the  
vacation of the same as petitioned for it was ordered that the Vindex report & view  
report & find of survey be adopted & the road be declared vacated in accordance  
therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record & the Trustee of Waller  
Spring Township be notified to cause the same to be closed.
