There were present Commissioners D.C. Walton, Chairman, John Hackett and P.A. Dolbe^r County Clerk M.J. Stevens.

The following proposition was considered and accepted by the Board
To the Hon. Sec. of Co. Comm. of Douglas County, Kansas. I would respectfully represent that I am the owner of two titles on the S.W. Sec. 18 T. 14 R. 12 based on the sale of 1869, with taxes of 1869, 1870, 1871, 1872, 1873 paid and endorsed. Also sale of 1873 with taxes of 1875, 1876, 1877 endorsed. Also sale of 1879 with taxes of 1879, 1880 endorsed. All of which tax sales are illegal by reason of a prior sale to Douglas County for taxes of 1866. Sale of 1867 with taxes of 1867 endorsed thereon; the principal of the said tax endorsements controlled by me amounts to \$275⁰⁰, the principal of the sale to County with endorsements amounts to \$74⁰⁰. I offer to redeem the late sales, upon which no deed has issued and to relinquish my right of action I have against the County by reason of the illegality of any sale of said land if the County will transfer to me said sale of 1867 without cost to me.
