The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered that Isaac Kilworth be authorized to redeem Lot 130, Rhode Island Street, Laurance, from sale to County for year 1859, for amount of original sale with six per cent interest.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the application of the County Superintendent for an appropriation for the County Normal Institute for the year 1881. It was ordered that an appropriation of One Hundred Dollars be made for said Institute for said year.
