

Linn, Kansas, July 12th 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk.

Those were present Commissioners J. C. Walton, Chairman, John Walton and P. W. Holter and County Clerk M. Stearns.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

The Board having under consideration Bridge Petitions as follows: For a bridge across Little Wakarusa River; Two bridges in Lecompton Township ^{and} two bridges in Marion Township, it was ordered that an amount not to exceed \$2000⁰⁰ be appropriated for the building of a bridge over Little Wakarusa River, near the Sec. line between Secs. 18 ^{and} 19 T. 13. R. 21, \$350⁰⁰ for bridges in Lecompton Township as follows: one over Leon Creek, one over Big Springs Branch, ^{and} \$300⁰⁰ for bridges in Marion Township as follows, one over branch of Rock Creek, ^{and} one over Appanoose Creek.

It was further ordered that necessary repairs be made upon the County bridge across Toy Creek in Palmyra Township.

Board adjourned to meet July 13th 1881, at 9 o'clock A.M.
