

Lawrence, Kansas, July 13th 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Wallin, Chairman John Wallin and P. A. Holton and County Clerk W. G. Stevens.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

The following resolution was considered and adopted by the Board: Resolved: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk be authorized to issue County Scrip payable according to contract, and deliver to the contractors of the County bridges as follows: one span at Belvoir, one span at Poor Farm and two spans at Lawrence, for three quarters of the contract price when they are satisfied that the material for said bridges is on the ground at each bridge site.

In the matter of Treasury Examiners for 3rd Qtr of 1881. { The Board appointed John C. Metzker, of Bond P.O., and Albert Headley, of Lawrence, to assist the Probate Judge in the examination of the affairs of the County Treasury for the Third quarter of the year 1881.
