Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Walton, Chairman, John Walton and F. A. Holber and County Clerk W. J. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of
O. L. Richards and others for the
vacation of Streets and Alleys in Eudora.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid matter, it was ordered that the following Streets and Alleys in the City of Eudora be vacated:

All that portion of K and J Streets between 9th and 11th Streets, and that part of 10th Street between K and J Streets, and the Alley in Blocks 94 and 95.

The following bids for Masonry were considered and accepted by the Board:
