Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment  
at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. G. Walton, Chairman,  
John Walton and P. A. Collier and County Clerk W. J. Stearns.

In the matter of the Proposition of  
Wilder & Palm to purchase the  
County's Interest in Lots 10, 11, & 12,  
Block 24, Clinton Village.

The Board having under consideration the  
aforesaid proposition it was ordered that Wilder and Palm be entitled to the  
County's Interest in Lots 10, 11, and 12, in Block 24, Clinton Village upon  
payment to the County of the amount of original sales without interest.

In the matter of the Proposition of  
A. F. Allen to purchase the County's  
Interest in Lot 102, Kentucky Street,  
Lawrence.

The Board having under consideration  
the aforesaid proposition, it was ordered that A. F. Allen, be entitled to  
the redemption the County's interest in Lot 102, Kentucky Street, Lawrence, for  
sale of the year 1859, for tax of 1858, for amount for which it was sold  
with 8 per cent interest.
