payment to the County of the amount of original sales without interest.

In the matter of the Proposition of
A. J. Allen to purchase the County's
Interest in Lot 102, Kentucky Street,
Laurens.

The Board having under consideration
the aforesaid proposition. It was ordered that A. J. Allen, be entitled to
the redeem the County's interest in Lot 102, Kentucky Street, Laurens, for
sale of the year 1859, for tax of 1858, for amount for which it was sold
with 8 per cent interest.
