

Lawrence, Kansas, Oct 6th 1881.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the office of the County Clerk.

The Board visited the County Jail and made an
examination of the same as to its condition.

In the matter of the Petition of
Geo. B. Swager ^{and} for the location
of a Road.

The Board of County Commissioners,
having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections
having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing
it to be of public utility It was ordered that the Viewers Report and View
and report and plat of survey be adopted and that the said Road be
declared located and established in accordance therewith full
record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the
Trustee of Wakarusa Township be notified to cause the same to be
opened for public travel. It was further ordered that the County Clerk
be instructed to issue County Scrip to Geo. Bruce in the amount of
Forty Dollars, ^{and} to A. Means in the amount of Forty Dollars, in full
compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establish-
ment of said Road.

Board adjourned to meet Oct. 7th 1881, at 9 o'clock A.M.
