In the matter of the Petition of
Wm Cleland and others for the
Vacation ^{and} Relocation of a Road.

On the 1st day of October 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Wm Cleland and 16 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation and re-location of a road described as follows: Vacate: That portion of the Road as now laid out on the South line of Section 32, Township 12, Range 19 which diverges from said line. Re-locate: On a near the Section line and extend East to a road 160 rods distant. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Wm Cleland as principal and F. Gleason as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that M. Hedgecock, Wm Barber and C. P. Kennedy be appointed Viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
F. Gled and others for the Location
of a road.

On the 3rd day of Oct. 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Frederick Gled and 19 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows: Beginning on the 1/2 Sec. line on the North of Section 4, T. 13. R. 19, thence running East on the Sec. line on the North of Sec. 4, 3/4 Sec. 2, to the N.E. cor. of said Sec. 2. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by F. Gled as principal and J. M. Newlin as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Andrew Douglass, J. B. Howard and George Leary be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
