

In the matter of the Petition of  
W.E.Giffith and others for the  
location of a Road.

On the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1881, a road petition was filed signed by W.E. Giffith and 15 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners, praying for the location of a road described as follows:

Beginning at N.E. cor. of Sec. 6, T.13, R.20, thence W. in Sec. line to Massachusetts Street in City of Lawrence. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by W.E. Giffith as principal in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Oliver Barber, John Deslives and Wm Miller be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board adjourned to meet Oct 8<sup>th</sup> 1881, at 9 o'clock A.M.
