In the matter of the Petition of J. G. McLaughan & others for the change of a road.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the relocation of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Verifier's report and View and Report and plat of Survey be adopted and the said Road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Lecompton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of Appeal in School District Changes.

The Board having under consideration the matter of appeal from the decision of the County Superintendent concerning proposed changes in School District boundaries in Marion Township, December 28th 1881, was set for the hearing of the matters.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.
