The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the aforesaid matter It was ordered that the County Treasurer
be authorized to Transfer to W. S. McCurdy or permit him to redeem any
Tax Certs owned by the County on sales prior to the sale of 1879. except on
Lots on Massachusetts Street, City of Lawrence. at ten per cent interest
to the amount of \$563.⁹⁹. without cost of transfer.

In the matter of the Proposition of
C. A. Menzer to Surrender Illegal
Tax Certs and take therefor 6c cents.
on sales prior to 1879. except on Lots
on Massachusetts St. Lawrence.

The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the aforesaid matter It was ordered that the County Treasurer
be authorized to transfer to C. A. Menzer any Tax Certificates owned by the
County on sales prior to the sale of 1879. except on Lots on Massachusetts
Street, City of Lawrence. at ten per cent interest. to the amount of \$630.⁹⁹
without cost of transfer.

Treasury Examiners for
4th of 1881.

appointed Charles Chastaine and J. W. Green assistants to the Probate

be authorized to issue scrip for the balance of contract for building
County bridges as follows: One bridge at Belvoir; One bridge at Poor Farm
and two spans at Lawrence. when said bridges have been completed
and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners. And also to
issue scrip to Robert Sterling for abutments at Poor Farm bridge
when said abutments are completed.
