

In the matter of the Petition of
Charles Pilla and others for the
Location of a Road.

On the 12th day of October 1881, a Road
Petition was filed signed by Charles Pilla and 12 others and presented to the
Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described
as follows: Beginning at the South West Corner of Sec. 9, T. 13, R. 21 E.
Thence North on Sec. line 40 chs to 1/4 corner on the West of said Sec. 9.
Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed
by J. C. Harding as principal and A. L. Cohen as surety in the sum of
Fifty Dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board
that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered
that Thomas Rayson, J. Conner and M. J. Brangan, be appointed
viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their
notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and
lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a
hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board adjourned Sine Die.
