Dear Mr. Parnell:-

Your letter of Feb. 1st, received:

All we want is the resolution passed by the County Commissioners, authorizing the refunding of the bonds in 1882 and 1883. I do not think that the Board passed a new resolution for every small lot of bonds which were refunded, but that no doubt, one general resolution covered the entire issue. This resolution is the one we desire to have a copy of. I think this resolution is very similar to the one you passed on December 29th, 1903 and which we asked you to repeal. I believe this resolution was closely copied from the resolution passed by the commissioners in 1882. I do not care for any fuller statement of the dates of issuing the bonds in 1882 and 1883 than what we already have. All I want is the general resolution which authorizes the refunding.

Also kindly have the County Clerk make a copy of the proceedings had when the bonds were originally issued, in other words, we want a complete history of the debt from the time it was incurred and all subsequent proceedings refunding. I know this is quite a little trouble but it would be required of us to furnish this complete history and therefore, I make this request of you as the County Clerk is the custodian of the records and is the only one who can furnish it.

We, this morning received receipt from Mr. Games your Treasurer for the \$33,500. Many thanks for the same. Hoping that this will not put you to too much trouble and that you can forward these proceedings immediately,
