Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners J. C. Walton Chairman
John Walton and P. W. Dolbe and County Clerk H. O. Gleason.

In the matter of the proposition of
J. I. Vitt for Lot in Lawrence. { The Board having under consideration
the aforesaid proposition it was ordered. That the County Treasurer
be authorized to transfer to J. I. Vitt the county's interest in Lot 133. New York
Street, Lawrence for amount of original sales and endorsements with 10 per
cent interest without cost of transfer.

In the matter of the Petition of
W. P. Biggs & others for the
Location of a Road.

{ On the 29th day of December 1881. a
road petition was filed signed by W. P. Biggs and 15 others and
presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a
road described as follows: Beginning at the South East corner of Section
Twenty, Township 12, Range 20. Thence running 40 R. N. along S. line of
said Section to the East line of West $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 20.
Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed
by W. P. Biggs as principal and J. E. Garrett and J. L. Adams as sureties
in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved and it
appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied
with it was ordered That Milton Pettibone, F. J. Wilson and John Adams
be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in
their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay
out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make
due report of their proceedings to this Board.
