

In the matter of the Petition of {
Wm Cleland & others for the Vacation }
and Location of a road.

On the 23rd day of December 1881. a road petition was filed signed by Wm Cleland and 17 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation and Location of a road described as follows: Vacate that portion of the road as now laid out on the Section line South of Sec. 32. T. 12. R. 19. which diverges from said Sec. line running N.E. about 100 Rods through the S.E. ^{1/4} of said Sec.

Re-locate on said Sec. line beginning at point of divergence thence running Easterly about 32 Rods on said line to the Township line or near it Thence Northerly on said Township line 80 Rods to intersection of a road which runs Easterly, 160 Rods through Sec. 33. T. 13. R. 19. to a road running Southwesterly from California road to near the Waparusa River. said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Wm Cleland as principal and J. Gleason as surety, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That M Sedgewick Wm Barber and O P Kennedy be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Re-location of a Road.

On the 2nd day of January 1882. a road petition was filed signed by J. P. Shirley and 23 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows: Commencing on the Sec. line between Secs 33. & 34. T. 11. R. 18. at a point 45 feet S of middle of track of K. C. T. & W. RR. and running thence in a N.E. direction until it strikes the Sec. line between Secs 28 & 33. T. 11. R. 18. thence along said Sec. line until it strikes the S.W. cor. of land owned by Wm Gleason. Thence North on line between land owned by Wm Gleason and B. F. Moon to Kansas River and piece of ~~road~~ between North end of Wm Gollubers lane and South end of Wesley, Garrett's lane. said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by J. P. Shirley as principal and Wm Gleason and B. F. Moon as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That C. Lohme R Richards and A R Winters be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
