

In the matter of the Petition of
Adam Schur and others for the
Location of a Road.

On the 17th day of December 1881, a road petition was filed signed by Adam Schur and 32 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a Road described as follows: Beginning at the N.E. cor. of Sec. 2, T.13. R.15. and running thence West on Sec. line $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to N.W. cor. of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 3, T.13. R.15. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Adam Schur as principal and J.W. Derby as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That Henry Cummings, John C. Moore and J. J. Stute be appointed Viewers of the said road and that on the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
C. A. Meenger and others for
the Location of a Road.

On the 28th day of December 1881, a Road petition was filed signed by C. A. Meenger and 21 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a Road described as follows: Beginning on the $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. line on the N. of Sec. 11, T.13. R.20 and running thence W. on the Sec. line one mile. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by C. A. Meenger as principal in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That W. B. Kennedy, J. Harrison and Foster Keil be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
