

In the matter of the Petition of }
Levi J. Sperry and others for }
the Location of a Road. }

On the 3rd day of January 1882, a road petition was filed signed by Levi J. Sperry and 11 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a public-private road described as follows: Beginning at the N.E. cor. of the S¹/₂ of the S.W. ¹/₄ of Sec. 6, T. 13, R. 21, running thence N. ¹/₂ mile to the Sec. line between Secs 1 T. 13, R. 20, and Sec. 6, T. 13, R. 21. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Levi J. Sperry as principal in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That Shad Whedow, W. L. Tuttle and J. B. Smith be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board Adjourned to meet January 4th 1882. at 9 o'clock A.M.
