F. to redeem Lot No. 42, New York Street, Lawrence, from sale of 1839 for amount of original sale without interest.

Election of Chairman of

Boards of Commissioners.

C. Walton one, P. A. Rolfe one, No Election. Second Ballot, J. C. Walton received two votes, P. A. Rolfe one. J. C. Walton having received a majority of the votes cast was declared duly elected Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners.
