

Lamar, Kansas, January 10th 1882.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. E. Watten, Chairman,
John Watten and P. W. Dolber and County Clerk W. J. Stevens.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

The following resolution was considered and adopted by the Board:
Resolved, That an appropriation of \$200⁰⁰ be made for fuel for the
use of the County and

Resolved, That the Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk be
authorized to issue scrip on said appropriation upon presentation of
wrights certificates.

In the matter of the dedication
of land for a County Road by
Jesse Savage and others

J. Savage and S. W. Burlingame owners
of land having on December 31st 1881, filed with the County Clerk and
presented to the Board of County Commissioners an agreement to
dedicate a public Road as follows: Begin at a point 10⁵⁰ chs N. of S. E.
cor. Sec 10, T. 13, R. 19. Th. var 73⁰ E. N. 44 W. 078 chs to angle stake. N. in line
19⁵³ chs to angle stake, N. 34 E. 1.01¹/₂ chs to stake in line. It was ordered
that the Road so dedicated be accepted and opened for the public
travel, consideration to Savage and Burlingame \$40⁰⁰.

Board adjourned to meet January 11th 1882, at 9 o'clock A.M.
