

Laurie, Kansas, April 13th 1882.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Waiter, Chairman, John Waiter and P. A. Robb and County Clerk W. J. Stevens.

J. L. Gilmore, Trustee of Frank Township made report of business of said Township for past year which report was considered and approved.

In the matter of Dedication of
Land for a road by J. A. Rasmussen { Abi Darnold, H. B. Sanders, Stephen Studebaker
James R. Jay and Peter M. Keen owners of land having on March 10th 1882
filed with the County Clerk and presented to the Board of Commissioners an
agreement to dedicate a public Road, ^{in consideration of the vacation of a road} as follows: Beginning at the N. W. cor.
of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 7 T. 14, R. 19, and running thence E. on Sec. line between Secs 6
and 7, and 5 and 8, T. 14, R. 19, to N. E. cor. of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, T. 14, R. 19. Dedication as
follows: Beginning at the Center of Sec 7, T. 14, R. 19, and running thence E. on $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec line
or as near as practicable to the E. line of Sec. 8 T. 14, R. 19, to intersect a road running
N. & S. amount of land so dedicated to be in accordance with the field notes
of the Co. Surveyor. It was ordered that the road so dedicated be accepted
and opened for the public use.

In the matter of the Proposition {
of Robert Beatty for Baldwin lots. { The Board having under consideration the
aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the Co. Treasurer be instructed
to transfer to Robert Beatty the County's interest in Lots 46, 48, 50, 52, and 54, on
Edwin Street Baldwin City, for three Dollars per Lot, without cost of transfer.
