owners of land having on April 15th 1882, filed with the County Clerk and
presented to the Board of Co Commissioners an agreement to dedicate a public
Road as follows: Begin at S.E. cor. of Sec. 1 T. 15. R. 18. and running thence N. on
Sec. line bet. Sec 1 and 12 same T. and R. 1. mile. It was ordered that the road
so dedicated be accepted and opened for the public travel.

the establishment of the same, and believing it to be of public utility It was
ordered that the viewers report and view and report and plat of survey

in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County
road record and the Trustee of Leavenworth Township be notified to
cause the same to be opened for the public travel.
