

In the matter of the Petition of
H^{rs} Smith et al for the location
of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the proposed road and no legal objections having been
offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of
public utility It was ordered That the Viewers report and view and
report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared
located and established in accordance therewith from surveyors store in
front of Smiths House as indicated on filed notes Thence North, full
record thereof to be made in the County road record and the Trustee of
Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened to the
public travel. It was further ordered that County scrip be drawn in
favor of Henry Wetber for \$10. J. H. Melser for \$10 and A. Tuller for \$60 in full
compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and estab-
lishment of said road.

In the matter of the proposition
of Mary J. Smith for Lots in North
Laurens.

The Board having under consideration
the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be
authorized to permit Mary J. Smith to take an assignment of or to redeem
Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17. Disappears Cent Sub Div of Adm 7. North Laurens
Sale of 1879. with endorsements. for One Dollar per Lot.

In the matter of the Dedication
of a County Road by F. Hill.

F. Hill, owner of Land having on January 9/82
filed with the County Clerk and presented to the Board of County Commis-
sioners an agreement to dedicate a public Road as follows: Begin at a point
25⁴⁰ chs N. & 45 chs S. of the 1/4 cor between Secs 21⁴⁰ & 22. T. 12 R. 19. Thence 10° E. & 8 chs parallel
with 1/4 sec line to angle stake, S. 31° E. 2²⁵ chs to intersection with old road 60 ft N. of
end of Bridge over mud creek. It was ordered that the road so dedicated
be accepted and opened to the public travel.

The Board had under consideration accounts against
the County.
