Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Martin, Chairman, John Martin and P. A. Dolbe and County Clerk W. O. Stevens.

In the matter of the proposition of Wm T. Sinclair concerning tax levies. } The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That scrip be issued for the sum of \$250⁰⁰ and the Co. Treasurer be authorized to transfer to Wm T. Sinclair tax certificates Nos 390, and 391, date 1867, for said scrip without cost of transfer.

In the matter of the refunding of illegal certificates and proposition of W. S. McCurdy, Geo Shearer, C. A. Meuser, B. M. Allaster, Geo W. Bours & Wm T. Sinclair.

{ The Board having under consideration the aforesaid propositions It was ordered That scrip be issued by the Clerk for amount of said certificates and the Co. Treasurer be authorized to receive said scrip in exchange for County certificates @ 10% interest on sales prior to 1879 without cost of transfer, and at legal rates on sales of 1879, and subsequent.
