

In the matter of the Petition of
Geo Anderson for the vacation
and location of a road.

On the 17th day of April 1882, a road petition was filed signed by George Anderson and 17 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the vacation and re-location of a road as follows: Vacate That portion of the County Road now located diagonally across the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 22, T. 12. R. 18. and Re-locate On the E and N. lines of said 1/4 Sec. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by George Anderson as principal and Thomas Anderson as surety in the sum of costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That Wm Barber, Wm H. Christian and Wm Haw be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they, proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
Walter M. Clark and others for
the location of a road.

On the 4th day of April 1882, a road petition was filed signed by Walter M. Clark and 27 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows: Beginning at the Cor. to Secs 15, 16, 21, & 22. T. 15, R. 20, thence N. on the line 4 1/2 miles to John Copples, said petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by Walter M. Clark as principal and Bladen Ashley and A. B. Lewis as sureties in the sum of Fifty Dollars, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that L. F. Green, Geo Miller, A. C. Jacob be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they, proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
