

In the matter of the Petition of
Christian Hoffmann et al for
the Vacation and Location of a Road

{ On the 17th day of March 1882 a road petition was filed signed by Christian Hoffmann and 25 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the vacation and location of a Road described as follows. Vacate. Starting about 20 R. N. of S. W. cor. of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 17, T. 14, R. 20, thence running in a N.E. direction for about 100 R. th. N. about 30 R. to 1/2 Sec line. Locate. Starting at a point about 20 R. N. of S. W. cor. of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 17, T. 14, R. 20, where the present Road leaves the 1/2 Sec line thence N. on 1/2 Sec line until it intersects the present road. said petition was accompanied with bond signed by Christian Hoffmann as principal and Frank Bonner as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that A. M. Kames, R. B. O'Brien, and Pat Fenton be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
R. A. Dean et al. for the Vacation
and Location of a Road.

{ On the 4th day of April 1882, a road petition was filed signed by R. A. Dean and 28 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation and location of a road described as follows: Vacate. That portion of the Lawrence and Emporia State Road that runs through the S.W. 1/4 and N.W. 1/4 of Sec 28, T. 13, R. 18, and

Locate Beginning at a point on the Sec. line between Secs 28 & 29, T. 13, R. 18 at intersection of Lawrence and Emporia State Road with said Sec line and running thence N. about 10 R. th. E. 160 R. N. to connect with Lawrence and Emporia State Road. said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by R. A. Dean as principal and J. J. Steele as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Fred Derby, J. C. Mettaker and Thos. Retifish be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and locate said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
