

In the matter of the Petition of
E. G. May et al for the change of
a road.

On the 6th day of April 1882, a road petition was filed signed by E. G. May and eleven others praying for the change of a road described as follows: Known as the Bloomington and Vance road, in relation to said change commencing south of Rome level near the Steele crossing and the N line of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 25, T. 13, R. 18, S. 2 - E. N. 5 R. to middle line of said 1/4 Sec. Th. S. on said line until it intersects a certain Co road running E & W Th. S.E. to the most practicable point to unite with first mentioned as now located.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by E. G. May as principal and C. Wicks and J. S. Shummons as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That Geo. White, J. W. Bullock & R. T. Hoodland be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
James Fitzpatrick et al for the
Location of a road.

On the 11th day of April 1882, a road petition was filed signed by James Fitzpatrick and 33 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows: Begin at N.W. corner of Sec. 16, T. 12, R. 18. and running thence S. on Sec line 1/2 mile Th. W. on the 1/2 Sec line to the center of Sec 17, T. 12, R. 18 Th. S. on the 1/2 Sec line to the S line of said Sec 17, T. 12, R. 18. and to intersect the local farm road. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by James Fitzpatrick as principal and Francis Hutter as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that August Holfkubler, Geo. Duncan and J. D. Cunningham be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
