

Laurens, Kansas, June 3^d 1882.

Board of County Commissioners met in special session at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. C. Walter Chairman, John Walton and P. A. Colburn and County Clerk M. J. Turner.

In the matter of the Proposition of Hugh Cameron. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered that the County Treasurer be instructed to transfer to Hugh Cameron the County interest in Lots 9 and 11, Bridge St North Lawrence for amount of original sales with 10 per cent interest.

In the matter of the Proposition of W. S. McCurdy. { The Board having under consideration the proposition of W. S. McCurdy it was ordered that the Co. Treas be instructed to transfer to W. S. McCurdy the Co. interest in Lots 44 and 63, Corn St Lawrence for Seventy five dollars and the surrender of all outstanding individual certificates. Without cost of transfer.

In the matter of the proposition of Wm J. Sinclair. { The Board having under consideration the proposition of Wm J. Sinclair for transfer of the County interest in 5th Lot 40, Mass St, Lawrence. said Sinclair having complied with the terms of his former proposition and surrendered the certificates therein named it was ordered that the County Treasurer be instructed to transfer the interest of Douglas County in said Lot to Wm J. Sinclair for the sum of Two Hundred and fifty Dollars without cost of transfer.

Bond Compromise { The Board having under consideration propositions from holders of Bonds to compromise the same at 65^{cts} the Board agreed to pay 65^{cts} on the dollar for said Bonds provided that \$50,000 in Bonds be surrendered at that rate.
