Resolved, That in consideration of the presentation to the Board of County Commissioners of original RR aid Bonds to the amount of \$30,000, for compromise and refunding at 60 cents on the Dollar by any individual or firm the Board of Commissioners will pay a commission of 5% on the amount compromised.
