

In the matter of the Petition of
J R Woodward et al for the
Vacation and Location of
a Road.

On the 16th day of March 1882, a road petition was filed signed by J. R. Woodward and 19 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Vacation and Location of a Road described as follows:

Vacate - Commencing at N.W. cor. of Sec. 24, T.13, R.17, running $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles E. on said Sec. line.

Locate - Commencing at the S.E. cor. of N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24, T.13, R.17, thence N. on or near Sec line one mile to intersect State road running E and W, said Petition was accompanied with Bond as required by law signed by J R Woodward and C R. Richardson as principals and C E Woodward J. H. Baum J B Richardson J S Steele and M L Kennedy as sureties in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered That S M Reynolds David Miffin and Gib Seaton be appointed Viewers of the said road and that on the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and layout said road giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board adjourned to meet July 7th 1882. at 9 o'clock A.M.
