

Lawrence, Kansas, October 5th 1882.

Board of County Commrs met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commrs J. C. Warton Chairman, John Walton and P. W. Collier and County Clerk W. J. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of E. H. H. M. Clark et al for a Road { The Board having under consideration the
aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the
establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility It was
ordered. That the Viewers report and View and report and plat of survey
be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in
accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road
records and the Trustee of Polymore Township be notified to cause the
same to be opened for the public use. It was further ordered that
an order be drawn on the County Treasurer for \$45.00 payable Jan 1st 1883, in
favor of B. S. Waughill in full compensation for all damages occasioned
by the location and establishment of said road.

In the matter of the Petition of E. H. H. M. Armstrong et al for a Road. { On the 5th day of Oct. 1882, a road petition
was filed and presented to the Board of Commrs signed by W. H. Armstrong
and 20 others praying for the Location of a County Road described as
follows: Begin on the Willow Springs Road at the S.W. cor. of T. 13, R. 19,
being S.E. cor. of G. W. White's land. Thence E. along middle of said Sec. 13, and of Secs.
15, 17, T. 13, R. 20, to S.E. cor. of N.E. 1/4 of said sec. 17, and to the Road along E. line of
said sec. 17. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law
signed by W. H. Armstrong as principal and W. C. Smith and Levi Shivers
as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses, which bond was
approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been sub-
stantially complied with It was ordered That J. J. McCre, Jordan Neal and
W. B. Kennedy be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon
the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they
proceed to View and lay out said road according to law giving to
all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings
to this Board.

Board adjourned to meet Oct 6th 1882, at 9 o'clock a.m.
