

Laurie, Kansas, October 9th 1882.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Comrs J. H. Weston Chairman, John Walton and P. A. Keith and County Clerk W. D. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of J. R. Woodward et al for a Road. { The Board of Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the location and location of the same and believing it to be of public utility, It was ordered that the Viewers report and View and report and plat of ^{and the said Road be located and located in accordance with the plat thereof to be made in the County road record} survey be adopted, and the Trustee of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use and that said road be closed. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip in the amount of \$10⁰⁰ to M. L. Kennedy in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the vacation and establishment of said road.

In the matter of the Petition of L. M. Walters et al for a Road. { On the 9th day of September 1882, a road petition was filed and presented to the Board of Commissioners signed by L. M. Walters and 35 others praying for the location of a private Public road described as follows: Beginning at the SW. cor. of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 36, T.12, R.20, and running thence West on the 1/2 Sec line 1/2 mile to intersect the County road as now located running N. & S. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by L. M. Walters as principal and Robert Carter as surety in the sum of costs and expenses, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered that O. Wolcott, Wm. Green and John McFarland be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
