The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same It was ordered That the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustee of Lawrence Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. It was further ordered That the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip payable in January 1883. and to the following named persons in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of the said road:
