

Lawrence, Kansas, October 11th 1882.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners J. H. Wadsworth, Chairman, John Wadsworth and P. A. Wolcott and County Clerk W. O. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of *J. H. Wadsworth et al for a Road*. } On the 2^d day of October 1882 a Road petition was filed signed by John Rahskopf and 11 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for vacation and Location of a County Road described as follows: Vacate: That portion of the old County Road that runs diagonally through Secs 11, 12, and 13. T. 13. R. 17.

Locate: - Beginning on the 1/2 Sec. line on the W of Sec. 13. T. 13. R. 17. and running thence E. one mile to E line of Sec. 13. of said.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by John Rahskopf in the sum of costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with It was ordered That J. L. Jones, J. H. Vincent and M. S. McIntire be appointed Viewers of the said Road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and layout said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

The Board had under consideration accounts against the County.

The following resolution was presented to the Board and on motion adopted:

Resolved. That an appropriation of \$5,000⁰⁰ or as much as may be necessary be made, payable from the Co. sinking fund to pay attorneys fees and costs in Bond cases.

In the matter of the Petition of *J. H. Wadsworth et al for a Road*. } The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility, It was ordered That the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and establishment in accordance therewith full and thereof to be made in the County Road record and the Trustees of Wraytown Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use. It was further ordered That the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Clerk's Warrant in January 1883, and to Mrs. Chas. Brown, in the sum of \$60⁰⁰ in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said Road.

Board Adjourned sine die.
