Proposition of E. J. H. Brooks. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be instructed to transfer to E. J. H. Brooks the County interest by reason of tax sales as follows: Sale 1868, 1879, with endorsements in Lot 48, Connecticut Street Lawrence, for \$50.00 Without Cost of transfer.

Proposition of E. Ira Brown: { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be authorized to permit Ira Brown to redeem from sale to County in year 1859, Lot No. 24, Ohio Street Lawrence for amount of Original Sale without interest or cost of redemption.

Bridge Contract. { The Board having under consideration the matter of letting contract for building a new Iron span in the Lawrence Bridge, the contract for building a new 180 foot iron span was awarded to the Mo. Valley Bridge and Iron Works at \$9450.00 in accordance with plans, specifications and terms on file with the County Clerk. Other Bids were filed as follows: Rust & Coolidge \$11600, Raymond and Campbell \$10,000.

Proposition of E. W. A. Menger. { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer to W. A. Menger Tax Sale Cert No. 1325, Date of 1875, Cert No. 1073, Date of 1877, Cert. No. 703, Date of 1881, Cert. No. 1115, Date of 1878, Cert No. 763, Date of 1882, for amount of original sales with endorsements with interest at 10 per cent, without cost of transfer.

Proposition of J. R. Floyd { The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition It was ordered That the County Treasurer be instructed to permit J. R. Floyd to redeem from sale to County in year 1869, 25th in N & Cor N 18th & Sec. 8, 13, 20, also sale to County in year 1869, 21st in E 1/2 of N 18th & Sec. 8, 13, 20, for amount of original sales without interest.
